
Diorama Book Report

Assembling Directions

Materials Needed:

- Planning Template	- Pencil
- Good Copy Templates	- Color Pencils, Markers
- Diorama	- Shoebox or other similar box, Craft materials you find around the house to create your diorama scene, scissors and glue
- Success Criteria	- Pencil

- 1. <u>Create a scene</u> from the book <u>inside the shoebox</u>. Create the background using paper or paint and add 3D objects to bring your scene to life.
- 2. <u>Organize</u> your information using the planning template. Check your <u>spelling</u> and make sure you have included enough <u>detail</u>.
- 3. <u>Complete</u> a good copy using your planning template. Check your work carefully. Glue the good copy onto the outside of the box. Use the labelled diagram below as a guide.
- 4. Bring your completed diorama to school no later than <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>January 26</u>, <u>2016</u>.



Diorama Book Report Success Criteria

- o I have chosen a book that I can read by myself. The book is fiction (a narrative or story) and might be a chapter book.
- I have read the book.
- I have thought about the main character and can talk about what this character is like.
- I have chosen a character trait (brave, caring, adventurous, curious....) and have explained how I see the main character using this trait in the book.
- I have described the setting of the story by naming the place and time the story takes place. I can say if the story is happening now, in the past, or in the future.
- My diorama shows the setting clearly.
- I have written a paragraph that tells what happens in the story (but I don't give away the ending)
- My paragraph has a topic sentence and a concluding sentence. I have three detail sentences in the middle.
- I have worked carefully, checking my spelling and punctuation.
- I have read my work out loud to check that my ideas are complete and clear.
- I have glued my information on the outside of the box, following the labelled diagram.
- My diorama is a scene from the book that I really enjoyed, or that I thought was very important to the story.
- I have made my diorama with details that help to bring my scene to life.
